Turn Right. PVRA is two blocks down Tierra Bonita on the Right Side. **From Highway 67:** Take Poway Road West to Espola and Turn Right. Turn Left on Twin Peaks. Turn Left on Tierra Bonita. PVRA is two blocks down on the Right. 14336 Tierra Bonita Rd, Poway 92064. Parking is on the grounds.

Entries: Entries Must Be Mailed. Email Entries Will Be Accepted, but MUST follow up with a mailed Entry Form including Payment. Entries must be received by April 1, 2024. Entries will close on April 1st or when the show is full, whichever comes first.

Opening Date: March 7, 2024. Closing Date: April 1, 2024. Email Entries will be accepted until 11:59 pm on April 1, 2024. This Show will Close when Full.

Licensing This is a Working Equitation competition licensed by USAWE License #024-082. That means points earned at these events will count toward your **2024 Year End Awards** We are offering L1 to L5.

Format of the Show: One day

Dressage tests will start promptly at 8:00 am, followed by Ease of Handling, then Speed.

Due to the time constraints of a one-day show, we will only be accepting 22 entries, so please don't delay if you would like to enter! Grounds will open at 6:30 am.

Prizes

Ribbons 1st – 6th for each trial. Prizes for First Place for Each Phase.

Ribbons and prizes for overall winners in each division (combining points earned in all trials).

Note: All classes will be run as Open classes unless there are sufficient entries to justify splitting into divisions. A class will be split into Open/Amateur/Youth divisions provided there will still be at least three or more entries in each of the split classes. In the case of a split, ribbons and prizes will be

awarded to each of the split classes. RESULTS WILL BE REPORTED TO USAWE SEPARATED IN RIDER DIVISIONS.

Entry Fees: Level 1 (Intro) = \$155 per entry.

Level 2 (Novice A) thru Level 7 (Intermediate B) = \$195 per entry.

State Drug Fee (\$14) + Grounds Fee (\$15) + USAWE Starter Fee (\$4) = Total \$33 per entry (mandatory).

All Entries Must Be USAWE Members. All NON-Members Must Ride Hors Concours (means riding for scores but not placement in the ribbons).

All horses must be registered with USAWE. Lifetime Horse Recording with USAWE is \$30. Go to: <https://usawe.org/membership/recorded-horses/> to register your horse (Scroll to the bottom of the page).

Entry fee covers all trials offered at each level (two for Intro and 83 for L2-L5). Non-Member Riders participating hors concours (H/C) pay the same entry fee, grounds fee and Drug Fee. H/C riders are participating for schooling purposes only (hors concours); they are not competing for awards/points.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

Cancellation: If the entire event is canceled, a full refund minus a \$20 office fee will be issued within 14 days of cancellation.

Refund: If a competitor withdraws prior to April 1, 2024 they must notify the show manager in writing. A full refund minus the office fee will be sent within 9 days of notification. Entries are non-refundable after April 1, 2024 Show management, however, may be able to provide a refund minus the office fee on a case-by-case basis under one of the following conditions:

- a. Withdrawal of a rider or horse is due to an injury, illness, or death. The withdrawal must be accompanied by a veterinarian's or doctor's certificate.
- b. There is a waitlist, and the show manager **is able to** replace your entry.

Stabling: **NO STABLING** is available on site.

Rules

The competitions will use the *United States Rules for Working Equitation Version 7.1*. Make sure you have a copy of the current rules. They can be found on <https://www.usawe.org/> -- go to the link for "Rules & Dressage Tests".

*****Use of helmets is required for all competitors under 18 whenever they are mounted*****

Helmets are encouraged for EOH and Speed events.

Liability Release

All riding competitors, coaches and trainers will be required to sign the USAWE & Poway Valley Riders Association liability releases on the entry form before being allowed to compete. Those entering online will sign the release when they check in at the show office, unless the scanned document includes all signatures. Those mailing their entry should sign the release on the entry form.

I understand that this is a high-risk sport and I am participating at my own risk. I hereby assume this risk and further do hereby release and hold harmless the organizer (Licensee), organizing committee, competition management, judges and officials; USA Working Equitation (USAWE), its officers, agents, employees and volunteers; the host of this event or competition; and the owners of any property on which the event or competition is being held, from all liability for negligence resulting in accidents, damage, injury, or illness to myself and to my property, including the horse or horses that I will compete at this event or competition.

ENTRY AGREEMENT:

By entering a USAWE-licensed competition and signing this entry form as the Owner, Rider, or Parent/Guardian, I agree that I am subject to and agree to be bound by the Bylaws of USAWE applicable to the USAWE-licensed competition, the U.S. Rules for Working Equitation ("Rules"), and the requirements of the competition as stated in the Prize List. I will accept as final the decision of the Protests Committee or Appeals Committee on any question arising under the Rules and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, USAWE, their officials, officers, directors, employee, agents, personnel, volunteers, and USAWE affiliates for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, USAWE and/or competition management may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage, or benefit of the competition, sport, or USAWE. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

In consideration for my participation in this Competition, **I AGREE to the following:**

- I AGREE that USAWE and the Competition as used herein include the Licensee and competition management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, and USAWE affiliates.
- I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse as a rider, owner, or parent/guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").
- I AGREE to hold harmless and release USAWE and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of USAWE or the Competition.
- I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of USAWE or the Competition.
- I AGREE to indemnify USAWE and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition I have read the Rules about protective equipment (section 1.9.1.k) and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty. I acknowledge that USAWE strongly encourages me to do so while warning that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching, and abilities to safely compete in this competition. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation, AGREE to all of the above provisions, and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf. I understand and AGREE that all competitors under the age of 18 must wear an ASTM/SEI-approved safety helmet.
- I AGREE that if I am injured at this Competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to USAWE and competition management.

Please read carefully before signing:

I am voluntarily entering into the following agreement ("the Agreement") with the POWAY VALLEY RIDERS ASSOCIATION (PVRA) together with their members, sponsors, property owners, officials, and affiliates and their respective directors, officers, employees, agents, volunteers, representatives, and affiliated persons or entities (all of these persons and entities will collectively be referred to in this agreement as "PVRA"). These persons may own, care for, handle horses, ponies or mules (herein "Horse/s") for all and any equestrian activities at PVRA facility. In addition to myself, I also make this agreement on behalf of the following persons who are my children or legal wards (under 18 years of age) and this agreement shall apply to me and the minors listed below:
List names of **minor children** or legal wards and their relationship of minor/s to contracting party.

I hereby agree as follows:

1. I have voluntarily requested to enter PVRA facility to engage in equine activities including but not limited to being near horses, handling horses, grooming horses, riding horses and/or receiving riding instruction, riding at horse shows (herein "Equine Activities") at PVRA facility and/or on its adjacent trails.

2. **ASSUMPTION OF RISK.** I am aware that anyone engaging in Equine Activities can suffer bodily injury including death, due to the unpredictable, dangerous, and powerful nature of horses. I understand that when frightened, angry or under stress, the natural instinct of a horse is to jump forward, up, sideways and/or backwards, and/or to run away from danger by trotting, galloping or bolting. I also understand that Horses are also known to kick, buck, rear up, spin around, strike and bite without warning. I also understand that Horses can trip and fall even on seemingly level ground and such trips can result in severe bodily injury including death to the rider, handler or anyone near a horse. I understand that these risks are inherent in Equine Activities and can occur with or without negligence on the part of PVRA. _____ **X Initial Here**

3. **LIABILITY WAIVER.** As lawful consideration for being permitted to enter facility and engage in Equine Activities at PVRA Facility and/or adjacent trails, with Horses, regardless of who owns them, I agree to assume full responsibility for any and all bodily injuries, including death and damages which may occur to me. Damages can include but are not limited to medical expenses, losses incurred because of bodily injuries or death, property damages, and/or personal property damages. I, for my heirs, administrators, personal representatives or assigns, release and discharge PVRA, and its respective employees, agents, insurers, representatives, heirs, assignees, and other persons acting on her behalf, of and from any and all claims, demands, damages, actions, omissions, suits, or causes of action, (present and future), whether the damage is caused by the ordinary negligence of these parties or not. _____ **X Initial Here**

2. **INDEMNITY AGREEMENT.** I also agree to indemnify and hold harmless PVRA and its respective employees, agents, insurers, representatives, heirs, assigns, and others acting on their behalf of against all damages which are sustained or suffered by me or my minor children, legal wards, and /or any third person who are not parties to this Agreement, including but not limited to other people, guests, etc. This indemnity agreement shall apply regardless of whether or not the injury, death, or damage incurred by others is caused by the ordinary negligence or PVRA, and its respective employees, agents, insurers, representatives, heirs, assigns, or others acting on their behalf. _____ **X Initial Here**

3. **HELMETS/PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR POLICY.** I understand that PVRA strongly advises and requests that I wear properly fitted and secured ASTM-standard/SEI-certified equestrian protective headgear while engaging in Equine Activities to reduce the severity of injuries.

I understand and agree that **minors must wear** properly fitted and secured ASTM-standard/SEI-certified equestrian protective headgear when jumping at PVRA Facility. **X Initial Here**

4. I understand that independent trainers may conduct business at PVRA but that these individuals are not employees, partners, or in joint venture with PVRA.

5. This Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement is governed by California law and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted under California law. Should any clause conflict with California law that clause will be null and void, and the remainder of this document shall remain in full effect. The Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement can only be modified by a written agreement that is signed by me and PVRA. If I breach this Release and Waiver of Liability Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement, I agree to pay the attorneys' fees and court costs related to such breach that are incurred by PVRA.

6. Release of image - I hereby grant Poway Valley Riders Association (the organization) permission to use my likeness in photographs, video recordings or electronic images in any and all of its publications, including website entries, without payment or any other consideration.
