Kasey said vehicles will be over budget by \$2000. We also rented a Water Trailer from the Rodeo for \$200 a week until the Water Truck is back. Jim said the show managers are doing a great job bringing in revenue and we owe them thanks.

**Work Hours:** Louann posted the Work Hours on the Website August 1. We will have the mid-year billing statements go out this week. Please check your hours. Kasey: Four members have already paid.

**Grounds and Maintenance** (Jim Walls): Jim wants people to do more work on the grounds. Dennis has been cleaning under the bleachers. Polo has a Polo Dummy and scoreboard under the Bleachers. The barrels can go behind the bathrooms. The Arena Repairs for Ring 1 we need to get started on and the work will progress in portions at a time. We haven't bought the kickboards and that was lucky due to the price of lumber going down. Polo is not holding an event in September so we should be able to get it all done. The October 9/10<sup>th</sup> Polo Tournament will be a two-day event. The Arena has to be done by the end of November because of the grant. They had to fill a hole in the Dressage arena so it is deeper still in one place. The arena still must settle. The Front sign is still waiting on a construction permit from the City. They still need to check and replace some kickboards on Ring 2. Waiting on lumber projects will only help since lumber is slowly going down in price.

Sherry said the Dodge sign was paid for on an annual basis but has not been renewed since we haven't had a Rodeo. The Dodge Dealership has new management. We need to investigate the terms of the sponsorship.

**New Business:** PVRA now has a contract with the Humane society that permits them to run evacuation events at PVRA. Kasey said the Poway Equestrian Center asked about evacuating at PVRA. When an incident happens, the Humane Society will dictate where people should go. In 2003, we had 300 horses here when the Fire started coming down the hill. If the Humane Society says go to Del Mar, we have to go to Del Mar.

**Horse Tales:** Suzanne Schlundt needs a replacement. She would help train a replacement. Kudos for the job Suzanne has done with that.

**Committee Reports:**

**Trainers:** (Emily). Rhonda is next due but she isn't training. Emily is talking to Kyla from across the street about training at PVRA.

**Chuckwagon** (Sandy Childers) The Hot Dog Stand is working well but we need more volunteers. The Hunter Jumper shows have volunteers. Other shows will need to supply them. We did get the Walk-In Refrigerator repaired. The cooler is down to 45 degrees. Jim said it was 38 degrees the other day. The cost was \$750.

**Rentals** (Nancy): If anyone has an interest in Rentals please contact the Nancy. We have interest in a potential wedding for next year.

**Polo** (Sherry): Sherry said that they will only have one game this coming Saturday. Sherry has confirmed that October 2<sup>nd</sup> they will be hosting the USPA Clinic. Then they have the Tournament on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> of October. Sherry is trying to get a college team going at San Marcos. An 8-year old player will be joining. Sherry said that the umbrellas keep getting moved and the bleachers should not get moved. If anyone wants grounds work hours, we could use help by cleaning between Arena 1 and Arena 2. Sherry says she invited all her polo players to the Gymkhana. There is nothing listed on there for a grounds fee, but there is no drug fee because they are timed events. The Grounds fee is \$10.

**Pony Club** (Sam Miller): We had four riders that came for the National Ratings Prep on the 31<sup>st</sup>. Sam is still planning to hold a Tack Sale. Jim and Nancy said they would hang on to the Drill Team Shirts for now until we find a new Drill Team Manager. We need to get it back up to 12 riders.

**Rodeo** (Nancy Kirchofer) Nancy said they have not had a meeting since they cancelled the Rodeo. We still do not have any plans for the Rodeo Event. We have released the Move-in and Move-Out dates but the PVRA board is holding September 24/25<sup>th</sup> for a possible event.

#### **Horse Shows:**

**Barrel Racing:** At the last show there were 62 barrel racers and the event was over in 3 hours. Tammi ran the Barrel Races up in Ramona with 100 riders. In Ramona, a horse hit the out gate going full speed when it was closed and Darcy was standing right outside and had to get 11 stitches. The riders like PVRA but the rings are deeper up in Ramona. When you have 60+ people the Warmup gets Crazy. Sherry said that the Barrel Racing could use the TV in the Entry Booth for showing the Riders time.

**Dressage** (Janice Kall): Need workers for Dressage. The date for the last show of the Dressage Series is August 22<sup>nd</sup>. We cancelled the afternoon on July 18<sup>th</sup> but that was because a lot of riders that normally come were on vacation.

**Fun Shows** (A.J. Burfield) The next Fun Show will be in October for Halloween. She needs more volunteers.

**Gymkhana** (Jim Walls): They will only use only two Arenas at the next Gymkhana. The next show one is August 14<sup>th</sup>. They might add a Gymkhana date later in the year.

**Hunter Jumper** (Emily Franklin): Kasey. Are we able to set up for Working Equitation on the 11<sup>th</sup>. Kasey said yes. The last show made \$2300.

**Working Equitation** (Janice Kall): The Show that was originally scheduled for August 22<sup>nd</sup> has been moved to September 12<sup>th</sup>. The last show of the year is Oct. 17<sup>th</sup>. Sam: We need more help from Men to set-up. It's heavy work.
