Directions/Parking: From I-15: Exit Camino Del Norte and Proceed East until it turns into Twin Peaks at the Poway City Limits. Stay on Twin Peaks and continue past Midland to Tierra Bonita. Turn Right. PVRA is two blocks down Tierra Bonita on the Right Side. **From Highway 67:** Take Poway Road West to Espola and Turn Right. Turn Left on Twin Peaks. Turn Left on Tierra Bonita. PVRA is two blocks down on the Right. 14336 Tierra Bonita Rd, Poway 92064. Parking is on the grounds.

Entries: Entries Must Be Mailed. Email Entries Will Be Accepted, but they MUST follow up with a mailed Entry Form including Payment. Entries must be received by September 6. Entries will close on September 6th or when the show is full, whichever comes first.

Opening Date: Sept 30, 2021. Closing Date: October 12, 2021. Email Entries will be accepted until 9 pm on October 12, 2021. Closing Date will either be when the show is full or October 12th, whichever comes first. This Show will Close when Full!

Format of the Show: One day

Dressage tests will start promptly at 8:00 am, followed by Ease of Handling, then Speed.

Due to the time constraints of a one-day show, we will only be accepting approx 20 entries, so please don't delay if you would like to enter! Grounds will open at 6:30 am.

Prizes

Ribbons 1st – 6th for each trial. Prizes for First Place for Each Phase.

Ribbons and prizes for overall winners in each division (combining points earned in all trials).

Note: All classes will be run as Open classes unless there are sufficient entries to justify splitting into divisions. A class will be split into Open/Amateur/Youth divisions provided there will still be at least 3 or more entries in each of the split classes. Ribbons will be awarded to each of the split classes.

Exception: There will be a Young Horse Class for 4- and 5-year old horses in their first year of competition as long as there are at least two horses eligible.

Entry Fees: Level 1 (Intro) = \$95 per entry.

Level 2 (Novice A) thru Level 6 (Advanced) = \$135 per entry.

Mandatory Fees: State Drug Fee (\$8) + Grounds Fee (\$10) + USAWE Starter Fee (\$2) = Total \$20 per entry.

USAWE Non-Member Fee = \$20 per USAWE non-member. **Do not send if you have a membership number!** You may also apply for a one-time waiver of the Non-Member fee at

Entry fee covers all trials offered at each level. Non-Member Riders participating hors concours (H/C means riding for scores but not placement in the ribbons), pay the same entry fee, grounds fee and Drug Fee, but not the \$20 Non-Member fee. H/C Riders can have a coach, on foot, with them in the competition arena throughout their rides. The coach is available to assist both verbally (providing instructions / suggestions) and physically (assisting with the gate, etc.) to help ensure that both horse and rider have a positive experience with the sport. H/C riders are participating for schooling purposes only (hors concours); they are not competing for awards/points.

Stabling: **NO STABLING** is available on site.

Rules: The competitions will use the *United States Rules for Working Equitation Version 4.1*. Please make sure you have a copy of the current rules. They can be found on <https://www.usawe.org/> -- go to the link for "Rules & Dressage Tests".

All horses must be registered with USAWE. Lifetime Horse Recording with USAWE is \$25. Go to: <https://usawe.org/membership/recorded-horses/> to register your horse (Scroll to the bottom of the page)

Although membership in USAWE is not required to compete at these shows, we strongly encourage all participants to join the National organization. Your \$30 annual membership fee helps support the continued development of the sport in the United States and helps fund the Performance Awards Programs, Judge and Technical Delegate Trainings, website, and outreach programs the organization offers. Join online at <https://www.usawe.org/> For riders' scores at a competition to count toward performance awards the riders must be a member before the conclusion of the show. Anyone who is not a current member of USAWE must pay a \$20 non-member fee to compete. Riders schooling hors concours (H/C) are exempt from this non-member fee, as they are not competing.

*****Use of helmets is required for all competitors under 18 whenever they are mounted*****

Helmets are encouraged for EOH and Speed events.

Liability Release

All riding competitors, coaches and trainers will be required to sign the liability release on the entry form before being allowed to compete. Those entering online will sign the release when they check in at the show office, unless a scanned document includes all signatures. Those mailing their entry should sign the release on the entry form.

I agree to be bound by the Rules of Poway Valley Riders Association and WE United I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, Poway Valley Riders Association and WE United, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.</p> <p>Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver, and Indemnification: This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing. I AGREE in consideration for my participation in a Poway Valley Riders Association and WE United Competition to the following: I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm"). I AGREE to release Poway Valley Riders Association, its staff and volunteers from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Competition. I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Competition. I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) Poway Valley Riders Association and WE United, its staff and volunteers and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition. I have read the Rules about protective equipment, and understand that I am strongly encouraged to wear protective equipment, while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.
